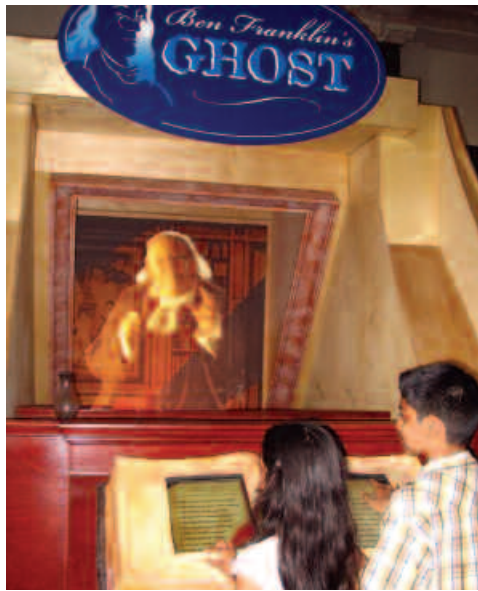
I'm your Liberty Leader, Annie. Join me for an incredible, moonlit journey to Independence — as it happened, where it happened.

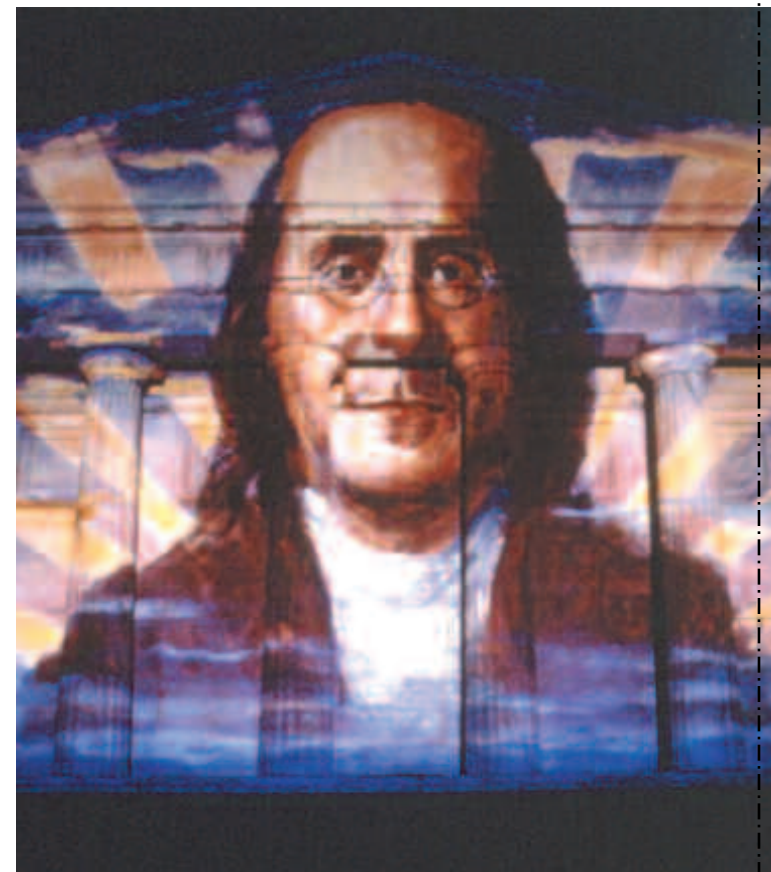

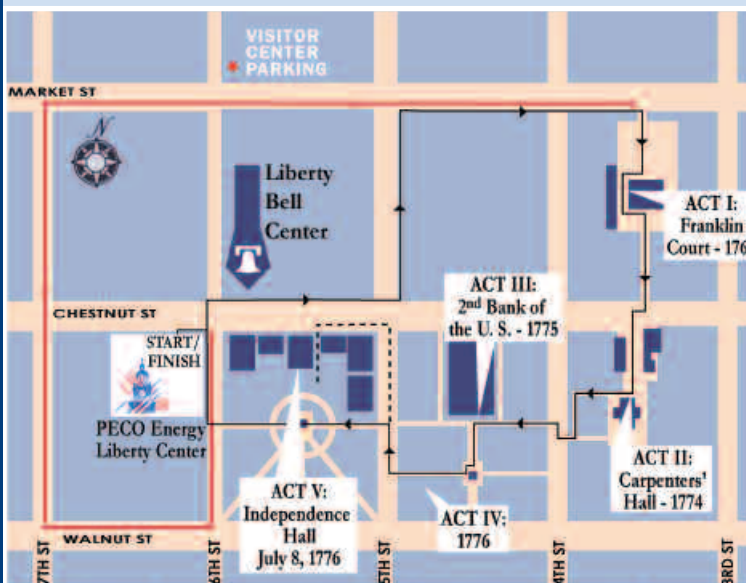
