The Civil War and Underground Railroad Museum of Philadelphia is rooted in an institution founded in 1888 by veteran Union Army, Navy and Marine Corps officers, to preserve the history of the era and promote public education.



Uniforms, weapons, soldiers' personal artifacts, letters, books and flags are among the objects exhibited at the Museum. Here one can view the uniform General George Meade wore at the battle of Gettysburg, a first edition of William Still's *Underground Rail Road* and the life mask and lock of hair of President Abraham Lincoln.

Children will enjoy trying on reproduction 19th century costume pieces from *Old Baldy's Discovery Dresser*. Children of all ages will learn the story of Henry "Box" Brown and see and touch an authentic replication of the box in which he shipped himself to freedom. They might even meet Harriet Tubman!

A changing exhibits gallery ensures new material for the visitor. It has examined such subjects as women in the war, the United States Colored Troops, English contributions, prisoners of war and Abolitionism. Our Confederate collection includes President Jefferson Davis's smoking jacket.

The Civil War and Underground Railroad Museum of Philadelphia is well known for its superb research facilities. To further enhance the visitor's experience, the museum offers regularly scheduled programs and lectures. The museum shop offers a wide variety of merchandise for all ages, from souvenirs to battle histories, toys and art work.
